



Spring Term 2025

In Year 3 this term we will be learning about:

English	In our writing lessons, we will be reading the stories of The Pied Piper of Hamelin and The Last Garden. These stories will help us build better stories, writing longer sentences using expanded noun phrases and conjunctions.
Maths	Our math lessons this term will focus on length and perimeter and fractions, including adding and subtracting fractions and comparing them too.
Science	We continue our learning of rocks and fossils within the Spring term and we will also start looking at light and how we see things around us. We will look at sources of light and how these beams of light reach our eyes.
History	Our History topic this term is all about Ancient Romans and the legacy they left when they invaded Britain. We will look at some Roman artefacts and think about how their empire grew.
Geography	Our Geography topic this term focusses on Antarctica. We will learn about why Antarctica belongs to no one country and how its unique climate and environment are explored.
Art	David Hockney is the artist we will be studying this term. His vibrant colourful and simplistic style will inspire us to paint our environment in a very different way.
DT	Lets get cooking in our DT topic this term. We will be designing and preparing a delicious vegetable soup, thinking about how food is prepared safely and the benefits of eating a freshly cooked, healthy meal.
French	Within our French lessons, we will be learning how to count as part of games and we will be developing our conversation skills further within the classroom.
PSHE	Our PSHE discussions this term, will revolve around our dreams and goals. We will also begin talking about how we stay healthy and keep ourselves safe.
PE	Within our outdoor PE lessons, we will be practicing skills and refining our ball control linked to hockey and tennis. Our indoor lessons will develop our gymnastic skills including working as a team using shadowing and mirroring.
Computing	We are learning about programming in our computer lessons using a program called Scratch. This will include using an algorithm to control a sprite.
RE	Our RE topic this term is all about Christianity. WE will learn more about the miracles Jesus performed before we looked deeper at the Easter story.
Music	As well as the music lessons taught by Rock It music, we will also listen to a range of artists and discuss how their music is made and how it makes us feel.
Outdoor Learning	As always, this term will see us visit the farm and forest areas of our school and we will also be conducting fieldwork as part of our Geography lessons too.

Weekly Homework:

- Your child will be issued with **CGP books (GPS) and a White Rose Maths** book. Notifications of which pages are to be completed and by when will be sent via **Marvellous Me** so that you will be aware of what your child has been told. This will provide valuable reinforcement of work covered. We expect that this is completed as it will be checked during morning work sessions.
- We expect all children to **read** their school reading book at **least 4 times per week**. This can be recorded on the new online reading record. Children will also have access to a school library book which will be changed weekly.
- Children should also regularly practice their times tables. Times Tables Rock Stars is the app we use in school to help and all children have a login which can also be used at home. In KS2, maths becomes increasingly challenging and knowing and recalling times table facts rapidly, is a crucial part of becoming a successful mathematician.
