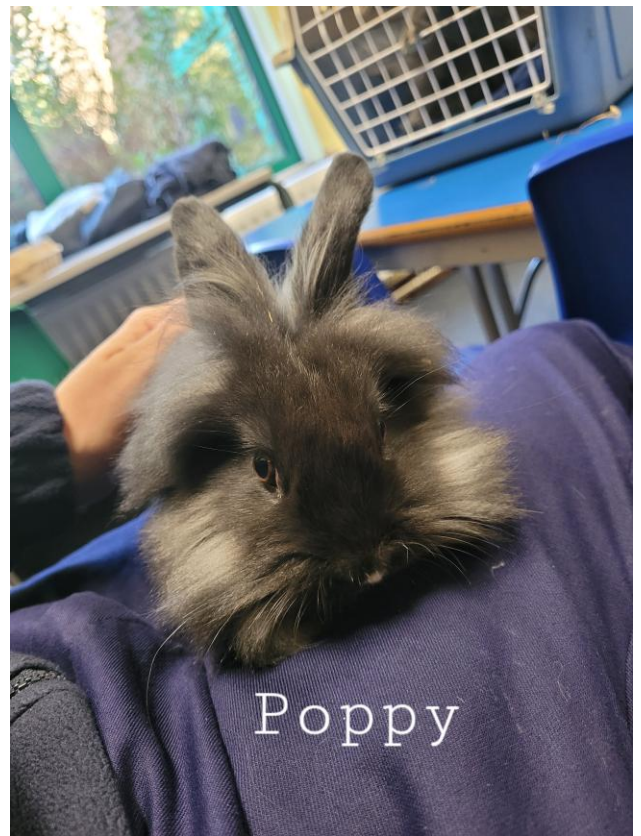
# Collaborative Working



Year 6 Derbyshire worked in groups to create a mind map expressing ways that Sanatanis show their devotion to God through the River Ganges.



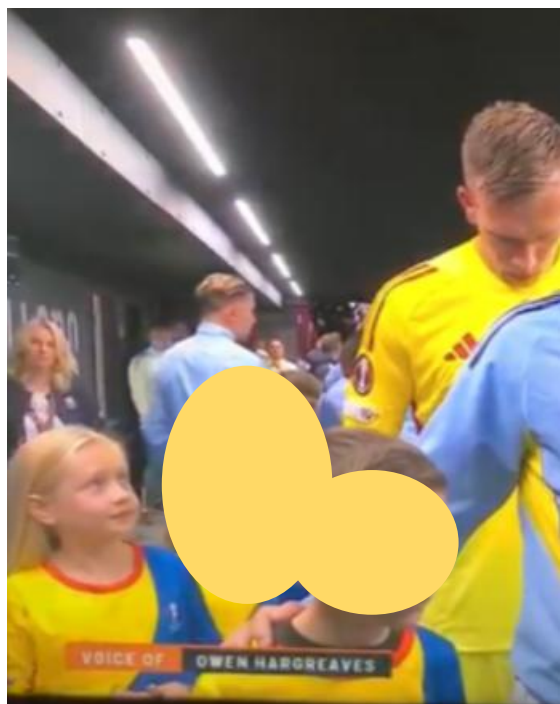
# Name the bunnies!
