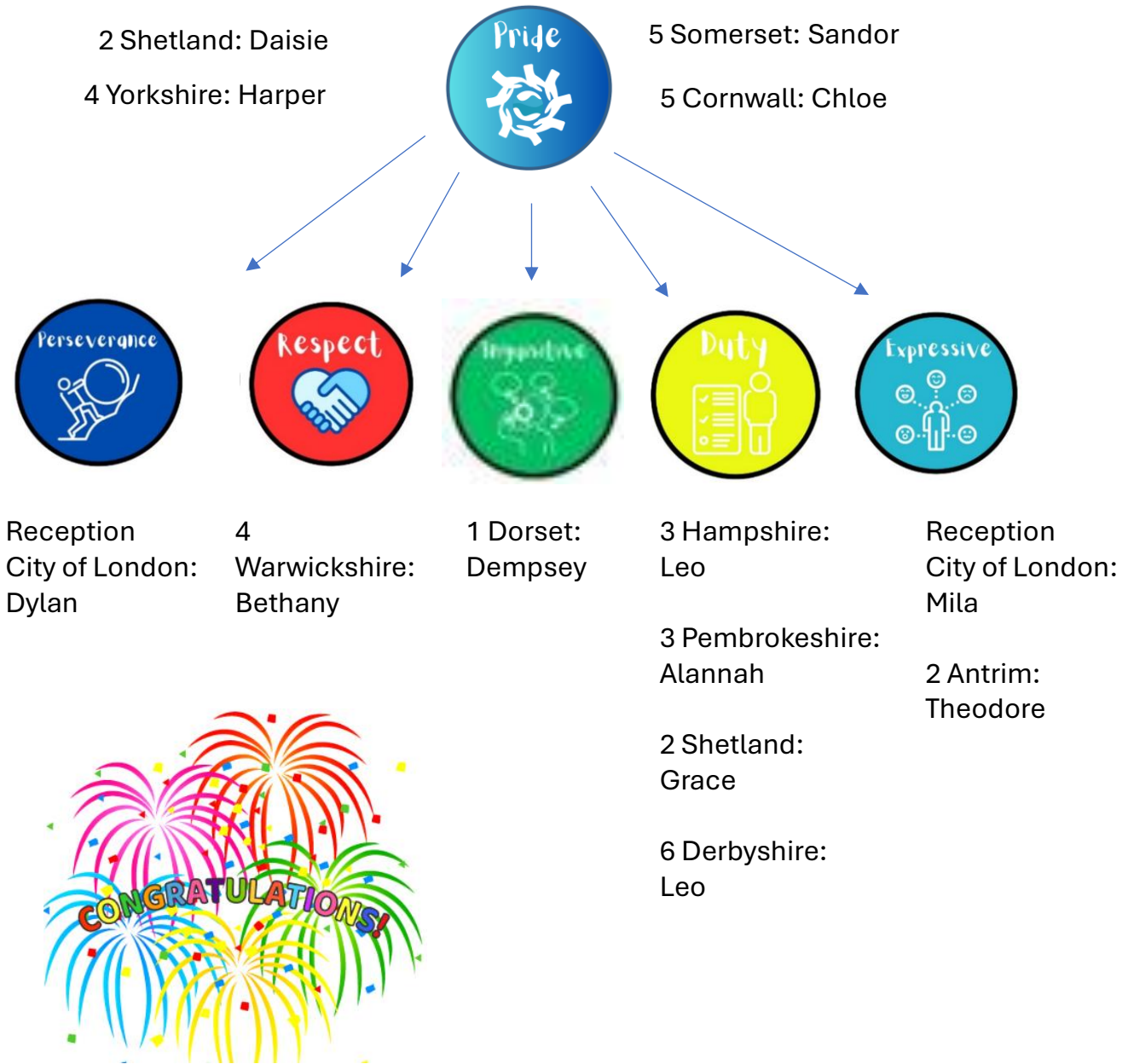

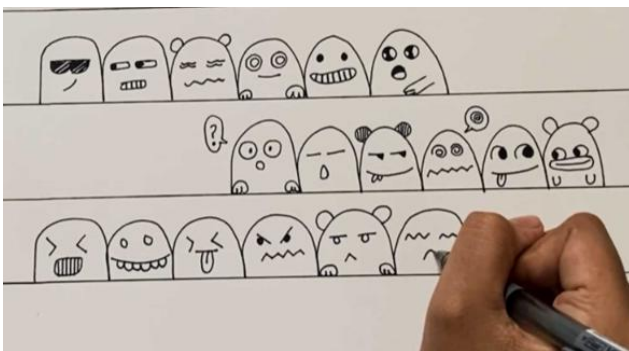

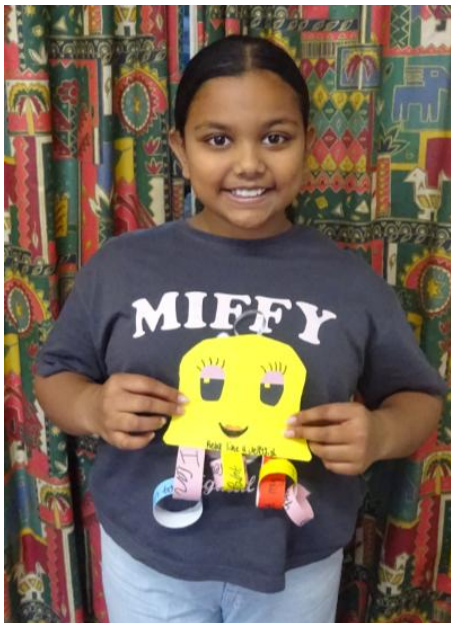

They played percussion instruments, practised their yoga moves, and danced outside with scarves in the breeze!





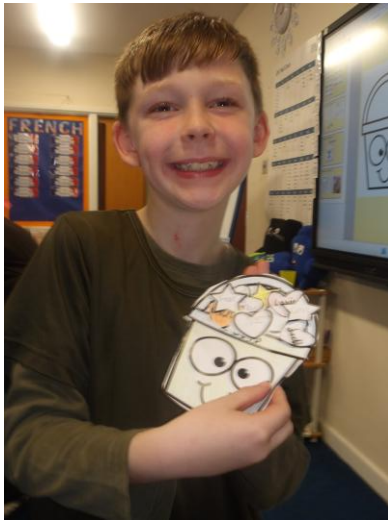
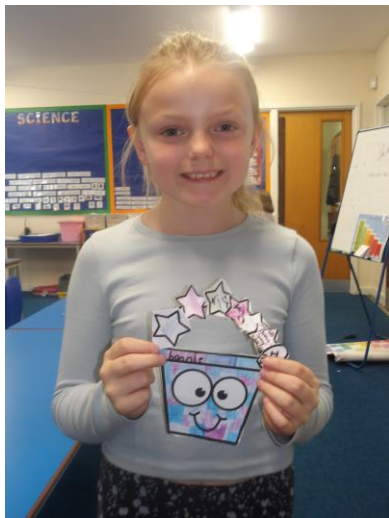
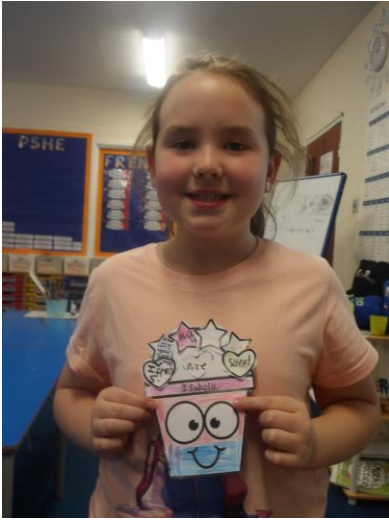
1 Dorset were out and about enjoying the Autumn weather! They took time to explore the beauty of nature around them.

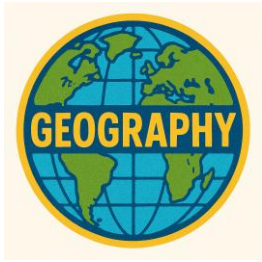
