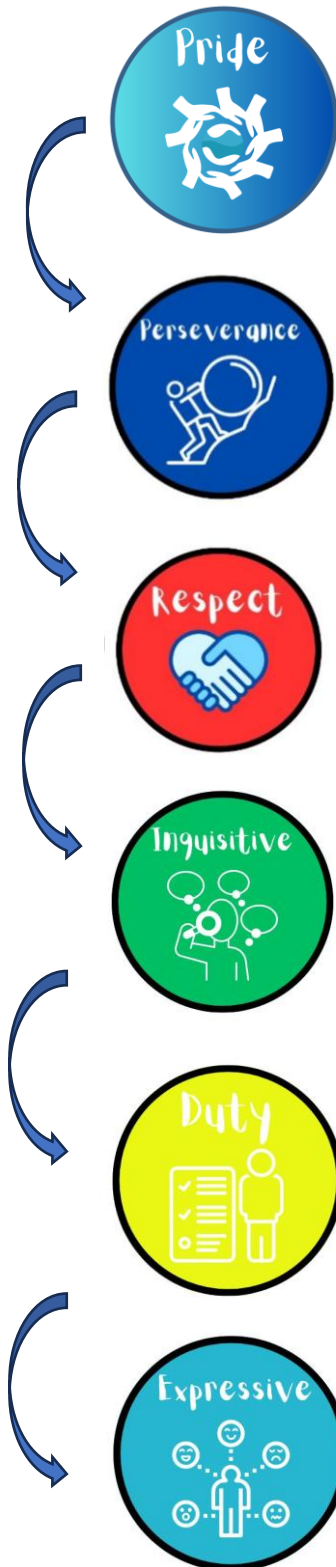

## Recycling Rabbit!

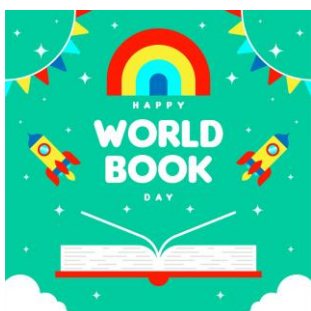

# Reception's week of celebrations!

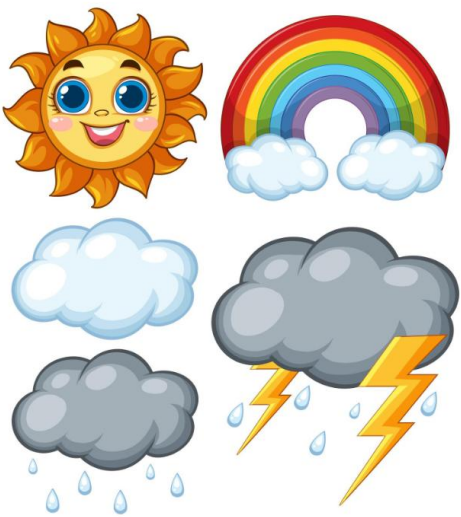
