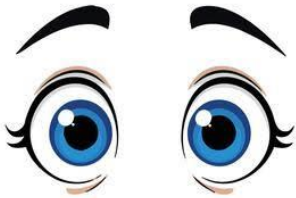
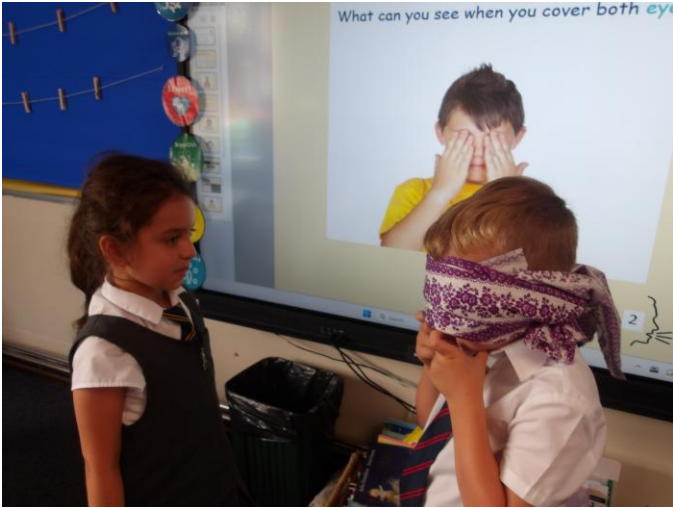
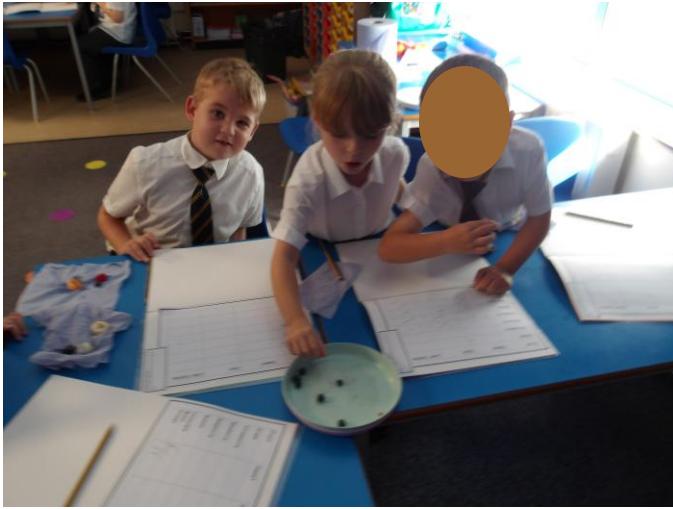

Dear Year 5 Designers,

Congratulations! You have been selected by Glascote Fashion House, one of the leading fashion companies in Tamworth, to take part in an exciting new design project.

Our company is launching a brand-new collection of stylish monochrome purses aimed at young fashion lovers. We need creative designers to help us create unique fabrics that are eye-catching, practical and inspired by the world's most recognisable fashion brands.

THE DESIGN PROBLEM

Many children want a small purse to keep their coins, keys and treasured belongings safe. However, many purses look the same and do not reflect the owner's personality.

Your challenge is to design and make a purse with its own unique printed fabric. The fabric should be inspired by the way luxury fashion brands use repeating patterns, letters and symbols to create a distinctive look.

YOUR MISSION

-  Investigate designer brands such as Louis Vuitton and discover how they use logos, initials and repeating patterns.
-  Design your own letter-based motif using your initials or chosen letters.
-  Create a printing stamp to produce your design.
-  Print your pattern onto fabric using a monochrome colour scheme (black and white).
-  Sew your printed fabric into a finished purse.

- ✓ Be suitable for carrying small items.
- ✓ Use a monochrome colour scheme.
- ✓ Include a repeating pattern.
- ✓ Feature a letter-based design.
- ✓ Be inspired by designer branding.
- ✓ Be carefully printed and sewn.
- ✓ Have a neat and professional finish.

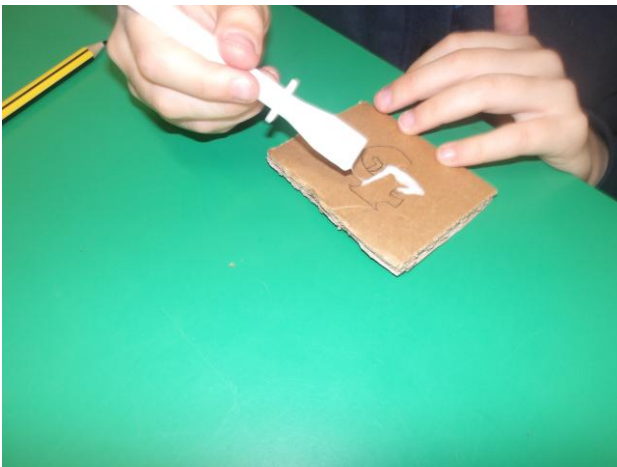
